



## What Is Day Camp?

Ask any Girl Scout and they will say, "Day camp is FUN!" At our Girl Scout service unit day camp girls participate in outdoor skills, try new activities, work in groups and make new friends. Girls are placed in groups with approximately 12-14 other girls their age, 2 adult leaders, and caddies (older girl helpers.) Our day camp includes exploring nature, swimming, canoeing, cooking out, archery, crafts, and activities around our "Mysteries, Maps, & Riddles" theme. Girls in grades 4-6 will also have the opportunity to sleep overnight in tents on Thursday night.

## When & Where?

**Date:** June 25 – June 29, 2018

**Place:** Camp Elk River

**Time:** Mon. – Thurs. 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.\*  
Friday, 9 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.

\*Thursday night, girls entering grades 4 and up are invited to stay overnight in tents at camp.

- **Bus transportation is provided from:** St. Odilia and Turtle Lake schools in Shoreview, and possibly Pinewood school in Moundsview if there is a large group.
- Buses leave about 7:55 am and return about 4:20 pm, depending on traffic.



## Who Can Go to Day Camp?

**Girls entering grades 1-6 (Fall 2018)** are welcome to attend. Girls who are not currently Girl Scouts can still attend as long as they register to become a Girl Scout member. To become a member go to [www.girlscoutsrv.org](http://www.girlscoutsrv.org) and click "Join us". Go to "Girl member" then click on round picture. Fill out and submit. The cost is \$15.00.

## Can I Come With A Friend?

Yes! Two friends may register together as "buddies" and be placed together for the week. If one is younger, the buddies may be placed in a unit most appropriate for the youngest girl.



## How Much Does Camp Cost?

**FREE for Adult volunteers!** Campers are FREE if a parent volunteers all week or pro-rated at \$33 for each day volunteered.

**\$165 per camper & \$60 per caddie**

Cookie credits/Fall Funds may be used. Financial assistance is available. Contact us for information on how to apply for a Grant.

Day camp is open to all girls regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, ability, or socio-economic status.

## What if I have to Cancel?

Full refunds are available in cases of personal injury, serious illness or family emergency. If you need to cancel for one of these reasons, please contact us as soon as possible.

Parents or registered Girl Scout adults can enjoy day camp along with the girls! Our camp is staffed, organized, and led *entirely* by volunteers who help the girls have fun, learn new skills, and make new friends. We rely totally on parent/adult volunteers to be group leaders, help with activities and provide sibling care. Day camp activities are pre-set so all the adult leaders have to do is supervise and help the girls complete them. The older girl caddies offer support in leading the girls in songs and games and outdoor cooking. Volunteers are asked to attend an orientation meeting approximately 2 weeks before camp.

\* All Adult volunteers need to be registered as an adult Girl Scout member. New members need to get a free background check. An online general Girl Scout orientation is also provided. To renew or register as a new member go to [www.girlscoutsrv.org](http://www.girlscoutsrv.org).



**Adult volunteers can bring the whole family.**

**Siblings' 0-5** can come to camp for \$45 per child for the week. A fun **Boys Group** is available for ages 6-12 for \$45 per boy for the week.

\*Registration for sibling or boys group is ONLY available with adult volunteer registration. This must be completed online as well.



## What is a “Caddie”?

Caddies are girls entering grades 7-12 (Fall 2018) who help at camp in various ways depending on their age, training, and experience.

There are three levels of caddies:

- **Junior Caddies** - entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade+
- **Caddies** - entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade+
- **Senior Caddies** - High School girls with more experience and training.

**Junior Caddies** - *must have completed* Girl Scout Program Aide Training *and* Junior Caddie Training.

**Caddies** - *must have completed* the additional Girl Scout Caddie training.

**Senior Caddies** - *must have completed* the Girl Scout Senior Caddie training offered for those who want to take on more responsibility.
